Thursday 8th June

General Election, UK

UK goes to the polls for a snap General Election, called by Prime Minister Theresa May. All 650 seats in the House of Commons will be decided.

Sunday 11th June

French parliamentary elections, round 1

Polls open to elect the 577 members of the 15th National Assembly of the French Fifth Republic.

Thursday 15th June

EU roaming charges abolished

The European Union has agreed to scrap roaming charges following a vote in the European Parliament, which should stop holidaymakers being charged extortionate fees to use their phones and tablets abroad.

Sunday 18th June

French parliamentary elections, round 2

Run off voting to elect the 577 members of the National Assembly (if required).

Friday 23rd June

First anniversary of Britain's referendum vote to leave the EU.

Sunday 25th June

Eid al-Fitr marks the end of Ramadan

Thursday 29th June

10th anniversary of the launch of the iPhone
